Brothers and Friends,

Our fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, is one for the ages. While the first half was normal, just about everything after Founders' Day was abnormal. We are not alone in what we experienced. However, I am pleased to report we have weathered the storm thus far and are quietly developing plans to be even stronger coming out of the pandemic.

During the past year, the CE&CF Board approved moving forward on two key initiatives. The first was to examine our fundraising program and develop an initiative to make the program sustainable and more successful. You have undoubtedly seen letters and surveys recently and I'll report back to you in the near future on what we learned and what we plan to do.

The second initiative was finding a replacement for OmegaFi, who provided website, fundraising and back office support to CE&CF for almost 10 years. Working with Bill Hoeb, we identified a local resource, Association Connection (AC). We entered into an agreement with AC in late spring and made the change effective July 1, 2020. They have assumed responsibility for updates to our alumni directory, providing email communications and general website and office support. We have experienced a significant increase in service and they continue to find ways to help us. Related to the change to AC, we contracted with CreateDev LLC to design and implement a new *ucpikes.org* website. Hundreds of volunteer hours were expended prior to launching on July 1 and work has continued to refine and improve it. My hat is off to Hobie for his dedication and considerable efforts in making this transition. We believe that what we have done will pay dividends for a long time to come.

Finally, CE&CF and the Pike Foundation awarded a record \$60,000 in scholarships to 35 deserving students. At the virtual Pike International Convention in August, Alpha Xi brought home their 10th consecutive Smythe Award, the Scholarship Cup for having the highest GPA across all Pike Chapters and the Alumni Relations award. At UC, their awards included IFC Overall Premier Chapter Outstanding Chapter, Overall Gold Level Chapter, Outstanding Brotherhood, Outstanding Service Event, Outstanding Chapter Event, Philanthropist of the Year and Outstanding Housing Corporation. Way to go Alpha Xi!

Financial Report

It was another year of growth and progress for the College Educational and Charitable Foundation. For the fiscal year ended June 30, 2020, the value of the CE&CF portfolio was \$1,249,727, an increase of \$100,204, and our account management fees amounted to 0.51% of the value of the portfolio. Total contributions from alumni and friends was \$147,366. We continue to be pleased with Johnson Investment Counsel and their management of the CE&CF portfolio.

Funds Update

We added the Karen and Bill Hoeb Endowed Scholarship Fund and the William R. Nester Alpha Xi Memorial Endowed Scholarship Fund (created by Harry Sparks). We now have 22 Endowed Funds, two Legacy Funds and a Real Estate Fund. Endowed and Legacy Funds are combined with the CE&CF General Fund and are managed collectively, but each is accounted for individually.

Each year the Investment Committee determines the amount available (currently 4% of principal) for awards from our endowed funds. CE&CF provided additional support in 2019-2020 and the minimum award from each of our endowed funds was \$1,500.

Creating a Scholarship Fund

We welcome the opportunity to discuss the creation of a fund. You may begin at any amount, but it will not become an endowed fund until it reaches the required minimum amount, currently \$10,000. Raise - Invest - Award

RAISE CE&CF is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Its mission is to solicit and accept contributions of cash and property in gifts and bequests without limitation as to amount or value except such limitations, if any, as may be imposed by law.

INVEST in 1994, CE&CPs funds reached \$163,735 and the Board of Trustees decided to engage the services of Johnson Investment Counsel. It was a significant move and our assets have continued to grow. In 2005, we embarked on a five-year capital campaign to raise funds for a new chapter house. It was extremely successful with 94 A% of the pledges paid in full. In 2012, the Board voted to use a major gift to create our first Endowed Scholarship Fund. It lit the fire that stimulated contributions from alumni, families and friends and continued growth in our number of funds. We entered the 2020-2021 fiscal year with 22 Endowed Scholarship Funds, two Legacy Funds and one Real Estate Fund.

AWARD The Investment Committee determines the amount awarded from the Endowed Funds at the end of each fiscal year. Early in the next calendar year, the Scholarship Committee select the recipients of annual scholarships/awards from the applications it receives and make their presentations at Founders' Day. These awards confirm, support and encourage educational excellence and may be used only for payment of futilion, living costs, and other related educational expenses.
